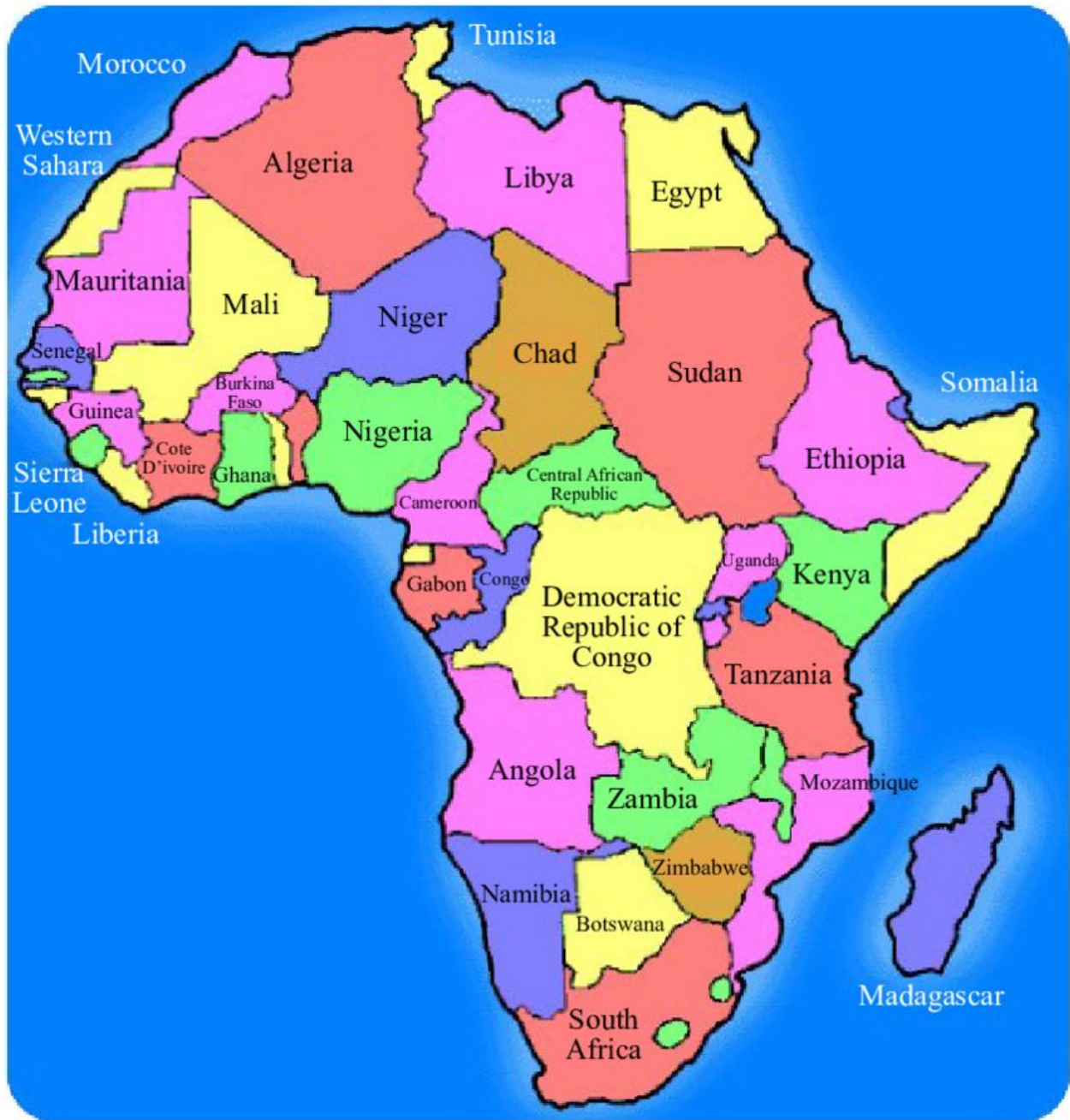

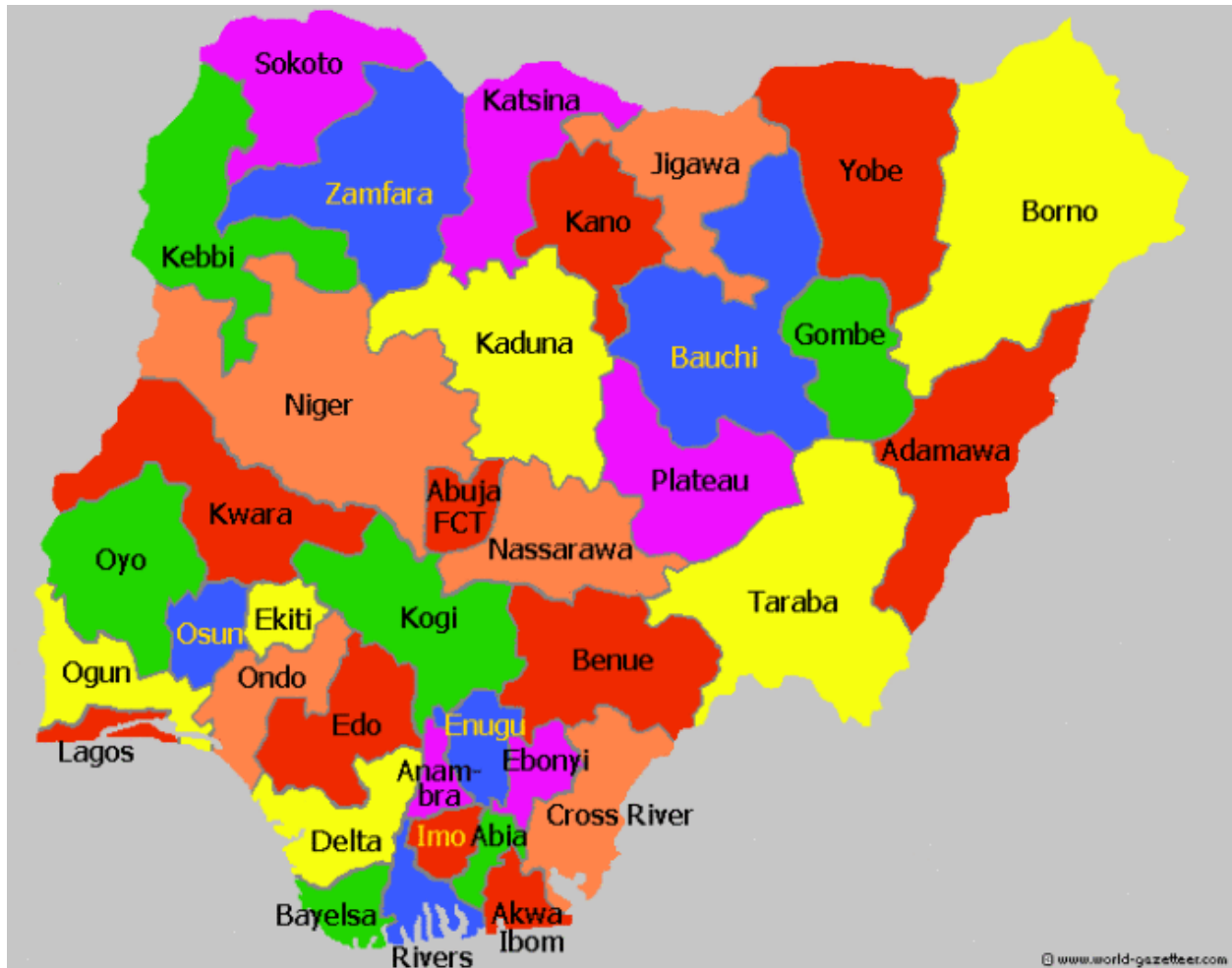

Hello Ladies, Gentlemen and Colleagues,

My name is Do Gun Harry Hwang. As of today I am seventy-five-years-old. I was born in Kimje Jeonbuk Province and I worked as a school teacher in Korea for almost ten years before I moved to the USA. When I was almost 30, I left Korea to go to the USA to study and pursue more advanced academics. At this point I have lived in the USA for 45 years already. During my stay in the USA, I have done many businesses like freeway maintenance and management, military base operations management, shopping center operations, real estate development, casino operations and I opened a university. I have done both small scale and large scale business operations during my career. About ten years ago I retired from all those businesses and I travelled to Cambodia and opened the first of several campuses there in order to help with third world education. Today, American Global Prep School is one of the top ranked private schools in the capitol city Phnom Penh.

Because of my career in the USA, in 2004 I received an invitation letter from the Nigerian government to come there. After that, I visited Africa several times to assess the conditions there. Last year, I received another invitation from the Nigerian government and when I travelled there, they appointed me as the Nigerian Investment Advisor. From 2024 to now, I have travelled to Africa four times and I have been studying the conditions there and the opportunities for businesses in both Nigeria and Ghana. I came back to Cambodia the end of August. I remember seeing the book that Kim Woo Joong, the former Tae Woo corporation CEO, wrote and in it he spoke about the world being very wide and there being so many things to do. I read this book a long time ago and as I have travelled over the decades I have felt the same thing he wrote about in his book. I have been to China 29 times to date and I have travelled to North and South America, Europe, South East Asia and even to Africa, and still I am not done with my journey.

Korea is small in its size and the competition between businesses locally is intense. I suggest we consider for a moment shifting our focus and activities to a place in the world that has abundant natural resources, wide open expanses of land and a work force that makes pennies on the dollar, compared to Korea. That place, my friends, is Africa. International competition today is accelerating and with AI and other technologies, it seems to be speeding up even more. If we consider South Korea and its place in the world, our 50 million people, when compared to the over 8 billion people in the world, are struggling to compete, both globally and domestically, and it's getting even more difficult each day. For many years, I have urged those I know in Korea that we must go out into the world and expand our footprint globally. It is the only way that we can survive and the best thing we can do for a strong economic future. I am very proud when I consider that in the 1960s, after the Korean War, Korea was one of the poorest countries in the world, but today, even with all the economic growth around the world, South Korea is one of the top ten economies on the planet. The reality, though, is that all that economic strength is based on

the results of less than a dozen major corporations in Korea and this is not good. Most businesses in Korea today agree that operations and profitability are getting more difficult each day due to limited land, rising workforce costs and increased economic pressures from abroad with tariffs and raw materials expenses and many agree that they cannot successfully continue this way in Korea going forward.

Ladies, Gentlemen and my Colleagues, let's go together to develop the only remaining land of opportunity and that is in Africa. Abundant land and plentiful natural resources, great weather and labor costs below belief with practically no competition, let's go there based on what is very clearly before us. China has recognized this and hundreds of businesses have raced to establish operations in Africa, but when it comes to Korean businesses, only a handful of major Korean corporations are there, practically no mid-sized and no smaller Korean businesses are there at all. For our own survival we need to develop a stake in Africa, challenge the opportunity before us with a frontier spirit, and thereby allow our future generations to thrive on the global stage. Not only that, but Africa is relatively undeveloped and by going there, you have an opportunity to help them by sharing with them so they too can grow. Travelling to another country and launching operations there is never easy but our future depends on it, so if we are to survive as a people, there are no other options. We must change and we must pursue something different than what we have attempted in the past.

Ladies, Gentlemen and my Colleagues, consider the Jewish community. They have 20% of the total economic power in America. Why is that? If we consider history, the answer is very clear. They have no fear when it comes to expanding into new territories and establishing businesses, even in the face of constant obstacles and threats. If we follow their example, we can learn from them and model their success when it comes to business and wealth creation.

I am not perfect and I am already old but over the last few decades I have developed a large network and I am willing to share access to that with you. In fact, I am happy to work with you through our Global Economic and Cultural Federation [GECF], a nonprofit based in the USA, and help you expand your business into Africa and take advantage of this opportunity before it passes you by. There is no one else that is standing here before you presenting such an amazing opportunity so I urge you to consider consulting with us before it is too late. Please don't be like the people who stand on the sidelines and watch as other people succeed and wonder why they couldn't make it. You have this chance right now so please, let's talk. 사랑하는 형제자매 여러분, 그리고 선배후배 여러분!

저는 올해 75세의 도건 황형규, 미국명은 Harry Hwang입니다. 저는 전북 김제에서 태어나 10여년을 교직에서 학생들을 가르치다가 20대 후반 미국 유학으로 45년 넘게 미국에서 생활해 왔습니다.

미국에서는 고속도로 관리, 미국 국방부의 군 기지 관리, 쇼핑센터 운영, 부동산업, 카지노 운영, 그리고 대학을 설립하여 운영하는 등 다양한 사업들을 하다가 약 10년 전에 모든 사업을 접고 후진국의 교육을 돕기 위하여 캄보디아에 미국 국제학교 (American Global Prep School)을 설립하여 지금까지 운영하고 있으며 현재는 캄보디아 최우수 국제학교로 자리를 잡게 되었습니다.

2004년 우연한 기회에 나이지리아 정부로부터 초청을 받고 처음으로 아프리카를 방문하게 되었으며 그러한 인연으로 그간 지속적인 교류를 하며 지내왔습니다. 2024년 5월에는 나이지리아 정부로부터 투자 자문관이라는 직책을 부여받았고 작년 11월 그리고 올해 5월에 다시 방문하여 상호협력 방향을 논의하였으며, 최근 8월 방문에서는 나이지리아와 가나에서 분야별로 구체적인 사업성까지 타진하고 돌아왔습니다.

광활한 대륙, 사시사철 온화한 날씨, 놀랄만큼 저렴한 인건비, 경쟁이 거의 없는 기업환경, 풍부한 지하자원...

아프리카 어디를 가든지 진출하고 있는 중국인들은 넘쳐나지만 우리 한국은 몇몇 대기업 외에는 거의 찾아볼 수가 없습니다. 이제라도 우리는 도전과 개혁의 새로운 길을 열어야 합니다. 물론 생소한 외국으로 진출하는 것이 그리 쉬운 일은 아니지만 우리는 어차피 새로운 개혁과 도전을 해야만 합니다. 저 유태인들을 보십시오. 전 미국 경제권의 20%를 장악하고 있는 저들의 저력은 무엇인가요?

오래 전에 대우그룹의 김우중 회장님께서 쓰신 "세상은 넓고 할 일은 많다"라는 책을 읽은 적이 있습니다. 저도 지난 수십년동안 세계 여러 나라를 다니면서 같은 생각을 해왔습니다. 중국에는 일찍부터 29번을 다녀왔고 유럽과 남미, 동남아 등 셀 수 없이 많은 나라들을 두루 방문하며 현장의 실상을 체험해 왔습니다.

저는 이제 여러분께 이 좁은 한국 땅에서 힘들게 사업을 하시기 보다는 좀 더 넓은 해외

로 진출해 보자고 감히 권해드립니다. 여러분께서 더 잘 아시다시피 지금 그 어느때보다도 치열한 국제경쟁이 가속화되고 있고 하루가 다르게 숨가쁘게 발전해 가고 있습니다

세계지도를 놓고 우리 한국을 보십시오. 아주 작은 우리 영토는 그나마 반쪽이 되어있고 그 작은 땅에서 5천만명이 치열한 생존경쟁을 벌이며 힘들게들 살아가고 있습니다. 저는 오래전부터 우리 한국이 살길은 경제영토를 넓히는 일뿐이라고 주장해 왔습니다.

지지도 못살던 나라에서 세계 10대 경제 강국으로 부상한 우리 한국이 참으로 자랑스럽습니다. 그러나 오늘의 한국의 경제는 몇몇 대기업 중심의 경쟁력에만 의존하고 있는 모습입니다. 현재 한국의 기업운영의 현실은 그리 녹록치가 않다고들 합니다. 좁은 땅덩어리에 높은 인건비, 글로벌 경쟁의 가속화, 갈수록 악화되는 대내외적 기업환경 등 더 이상 한국에서 지속가능한 기업으로 유지하기가 너무 힘들다고 아우성입니다.

저도 완벽한 것은 아니고 이미 나이도 들었지만, 지난 수십 년 동안 폭넓은 글로벌 네트워크를 구축해 왔으며, 그 네트워크를 이제 여러분과 공유하고자 합니다. 미국에 본사를 둔 비영리 단체인 세계경제문화연합회(GECF)을 통해 여러분과 함께 일하게 된다면 저의 큰 기쁨이 될 것입니다. GECF가 여러분의 아프리카 진출을 지원하고, 지금의 기회가 지나가기 전에 여러분께서 그 기회를 놓치지 않도록 나서서 도와드리겠습니다.

여러분에 앞장서서 이처럼 놀라운 기회를 제시하는 사람도 여러분 인생에 흔치는 않을 것입니다. 너무 늦기 전에 저희에게 문의해 보시기를 강력히 권합니다. 다른 사람들이 성공하는 것을 옆에서 지켜보면서 왜 자신은 성공하지 못했을까 아쉬워하는 사람들처럼 지금 바로 여러분 앞에 펼쳐진 이 기회를 방관하지 마시기 바랍니다. 우리 함께 대화를 나눠보십시오. 연락 주시면 여러분과 여러분 가족, 그리고 우리 모두의 미래를 위해 우리가 어떻게 함께 일할 수 있을지 깊이 고민해 보겠습니다.

아프리카는 54개국에 14억명이 살고 있고 나이지리아에만 2억 3천만명이 살고 있습니다. 저도 부족한 사람이지만 제가 여러분들의 아프리카의 진출을 최선을 다해서 도와드리겠습니다.

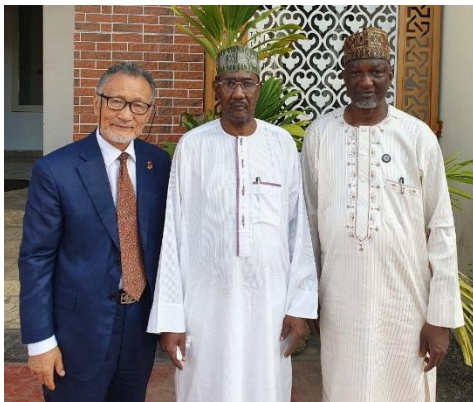

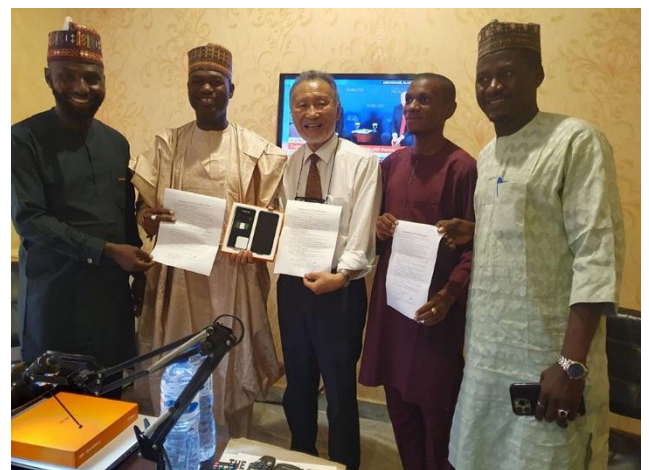

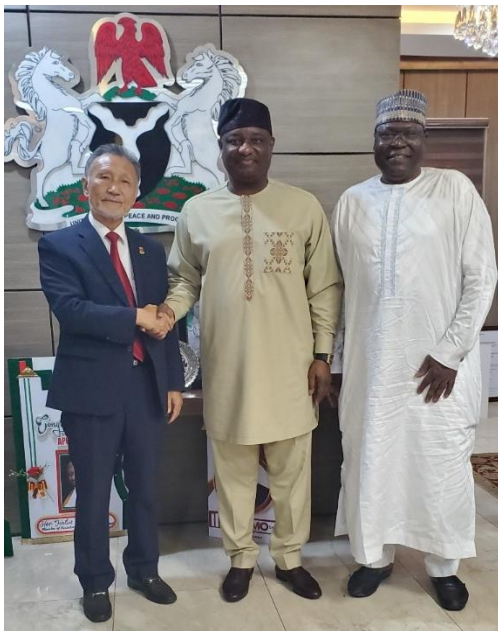
